

Privacy Policy – SLADA and Anti-Doping Activities



Sri Lanka Anti-Doping Agency (SLADA) leads efforts to ensure clean and fair sports competitions through anti-doping measures. We are an organization established under the Convention against doping in sports Act no. 33/2013.

This Privacy Policy outlines how SLADA collects, uses, shares, and manages personal information in connection with anti-doping activities.

INFORMATION FOR ATHLETES

TYPES OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

Personal information refers to data that identifies an individual, such as name and address.

The types of personal information SLADA holds about athletes depend on their level of participation and the application of anti-doping rules. For example, athletes with no history of prohibited substance use won't have an adverse analytical finding (AAF) case file.

In this policy, Doping Control Data encompasses Athlete Profile, Whereabouts, Testing, Therapeutic Use Exemption, Athlete Biological Passport, Results Management, and Intelligence and Investigations information.

WHY SLADA COLLECTS AND USES YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

SLADA utilizes the personal information it obtains for anti-doping purposes as outlined in the Code and International Standards. This includes:

- Ensuring Harmonized and Compliant Anti-Doping Processes
- Building Anti-Doping Capacity

- Conducting Testing and Investigations
- Operating and Managing ADAMS
- Reporting on and Improving Anti-Doping Processes

SHARING OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

SLADA and its partners may access personal information for anti-doping purposes, ensuring compliance with legal and ethical standards.

- Compliance with Law and Anti-Doping Investigations

SLADA may disclose personal information to authorities as required by law, particularly in the context of investigations into breaches of anti-doping regulations.

- Other organizations

Other anti-doping organizations may access athlete information in ADAMS for legitimate anti-doping purposes.

YOUR RIGHTS

You may have rights under applicable laws and standards, including access, correction, and deletion of personal information. However, certain anti-doping processes may be mandatory, limiting these rights.

SAFEGUARDS

SLADA employs organizational, technical, physical, and contractual measures to safeguard personal information against unauthorized access.

RETENTION

Personal information will be retained in accordance with relevant standards, with exceptions for ongoing anti-doping activities or legal requirements.

LAWFUL PROCESSING

SLADA processes personal information for anti-doping purposes, relying on legal authorities, consent where applicable, and the importance of anti-doping activities to public interests.

TYPES OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

Non-athlete personal information includes identifying information, contact details, affiliations, and Technical Data.

WHY SLADA COLLECTS AND USES YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

SLADA uses non-athlete personal information for anti-doping purposes, including account administration, platform operation, integrity verification, investigations, and research.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

Non-athlete individuals are responsible for protecting and using personal information in compliance with anti-doping regulations and privacy standards.
