THE DISCIPLINARY PANEL OF SRI LANKA ANTI -DOPING AGENCY HELD THE DISCIPLINARY INQUIRY ON 13TH MARCH 2018 AND 10TH MAY 2018 AT 3.30 PM. AT THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF SPORTS SCIENCE, NO. 100/7, INDEPENDENCE AVENUE, COLOMBO - 07.

As per the UNESCO Convention, Sri Lanka is a Signatory (Member) to the WADA Code. Accordingly Sri Lanka Anti -Doping Agency is obliged to give effect to and uphold the provisions of the WADA Code.

We the Signatories for the Sri Lanka Disciplinary Panel appointed by the Chairman, Sri Lanka Anti-Doping Agency hereby determine, adjudicate and declare our findings and the decision as follows :-

BACKGROUND

Mr. Dhanushka Perera (hereinafter referred to as the athlete) was tested on 07.01.2018 as an "In Competition Testing" at the DIALOG CLIFFORD CUP. The Number assigned to his urine sample is 4067569. The athlete signed a Doping Control Form in which he acknowledged that his urine sample collection was carried out in accordance with the relevant procedure laid down in the WADA Code. In the said form, under "Declaration of Medication and Blood Transfusions" the athlete has stated "Depomedrol, cataffam 80 ml, fish oil, creatine, Nitroteli,

Vitamin BCAA, Glutamine, Thyroid Medicine, "(The Doping Control Form of SLADA dated 07.01.2018 signed by the athlete is herewith produced and marked as "X1")

The athlete's urine sample (bearing Sample No. 4067569) was sent to the National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL) in India (a WADA accredited laboratory). SLADA received the report of the said sample dated 01.02.2018. The sample "A" was found to be positive and the report states that "Adverse Analytical Finding for 1. 3-oh Stanozolol & 16B - OH Stanozolol, Anabolic Steroid, Ephedrine, Oxilofrine," (A copy of the said Report of the National Dope Testing Laboratory dated 01.02.2018 is herewith produced and marked as "X2").

The presence of the prohibited substances in an athlete's urine sample *prima facie* constitutes an Anti-Doping Rule Violation under Article 2.1 of the WADA Code.

PRELIMINARY INQUIRY

In the event of a positive result, the athlete should be given the opportunity to face a preliminary inquiry to state whether he wished to request for the testing of the B sample within the prescribed period of seven days starting from the date appeared on the testing report ("X2"). In this case, both the accused athlete Mr. Dhanushka Perera and the Secretary of the Sri Lanka Rugby were informed by the letters dated 02.02.2018 of the results of the laboratory test report and also asked the athlete to participate in the preliminary inquiry.

(Copies of the said letters dated 02.02.2018 addressed to the Secretary of the Sri Lanka Rugby and copied to the Athlete are herewith produced and marked as "X3" and "X4")

The Athlete Mr. Dhanushka Perera reported to Sri Lanka Anti-Doping Agency on 07.02.2018. The accused athlete participated for the preliminary inquiry accordingly the athlete answered that he will not go for the analysis of his Sample B.

THE DISCIPLINARY INQUIRY

The disciplinary Inquiry into the doping rule violation by the accused athlete Mr. Dhanushka Perera was conducted by Sri Lanka Anti - doping Disciplinary Panel on 13.03.2018 and 10.05.2018 at the National Institute of Sports Science (NISS), Colombo 07.

At the first date he has appeared with his attorney -At-Law and requested to submit his answers by way of an affidavit and submitted on 29.03.2018.

Mr. Dhanushka Perera in his affidavit has objected to the results of the Doping control analytical report dated 01.02.2018 on the following grounds.

1. Degrading of the Urine sample

~~2. Tampering with the Urine sample~~

On 10.05.2018 Mr. Dhanushka Perera has further stated at the inquiry that he has not taken any prohibited drugs but has only taken energy drinks namely Red Bull, No Sport and Jeewanie.

The panel has summoned Dr. Pilapitiya, Director testing and Education SLADA for her evidence.

EVIDENCE OF THE ATHLETE

At the hearing of the disciplinary Inquiry the accused athlete accepted the fact that the doping charge has been leveled against him but he said that he denies the charge since he has never taken any prohibited substance.

He has confirmed that he has enough knowledge about the substance which has been listed as prohibited.

CRITERIA OF ANALYSING THE EVIDENCE

Upon the facts of the Laboratory Report marked "X2", an Adverse Analytical Finding has been reported by the National Dope Testing Laboratory (NDTL) in the Urine Sample A of the accused athlete Mr. Dhanushka Perera which amounts to constitute an offence within the meaning of Article 2.1 of the World Anti-Doping Code 2015 that states as follows;

It is each athlete's personal duty to ensure that no Prohibited Substance enters his or her body. Athletes are responsible for any Prohibited Substance or its Metabolites or Markers found to be present in their Samples. Accordingly, it is not necessary that intent, fault, negligence or knowing use on the Athlete's part be demonstrated in order to establish an anti-doping rule violation under Article 2.1. "

In view of the all material evidence placed before the Sri Lanka Anti-Doping Disciplinary Panel, we determine that within the meaning of required standard of proof set out in Article 3.1 of

the WADA Code, the relevant charge against the accused athlete Mr. Dhanushka Perera for the violation of Article 2.1 of the WADA Code has been established to the comfortable satisfaction of proof greater than a mere balance of probability but less than proof beyond a reasonable doubt:

In respect of Article 10.2.1 of the WADA Code, the period of ineligibility shall be four years for a violation of Article 2.1 of the Code where the anti-doping rule violation does not involve a specified substance.

The substances of 1. 3-OH Stanozolol & 16B - OH Stanozolol, Anabolic Steroid, Ephedrine, Oxilofrine which are reported to be present in the Sample A of the accused athlete are Non-specified Substance prescribed in the Class S1 - Anabolic Agents in the WADA Prohibited List 2017.





However, in this case the athlete could not establish that the anti-doping rule violation purported to be committed by him was not intentional.

SANCTION

Hence, as per the provisions of the WADA Code cited above, we, the Sri Lanka Anti-Doping Disciplinary Panel is of the unanimous view to recommend imposition of a sanction of FOUR YEARS INELIGIBILITY PERIOD on the aforementioned athlete Mr. DHANUSHKA PERERA as to commence from 07.01.2018 and up to 06.01.2022.

And we severely warn him to avoid from taking all the vitamins and supplements which may have contained Prohibited Substances and before taking or injecting anything into his body to make sure whether it contains Prohibited Substances or not. As an athlete competing at the national and international levels, he owes a duty and responsibility in this regard. He should improve his knowledge not only on the Prohibited Substances, but also on the Prohibited List published by WADA annually.

An Adverse Analytical Finding has been reported in the Urine Sample Code 4067569 of the athlete Mr. Danushka Perera which was collected on 07.01.2018 in Colombo as an in-competition testing.

The Doping Control Analytical Report dated 01.02.2018 and received from National Dope Testing Laboratory (WADA accredited Lab, Copy Attached) has reported for

1. Adverse analytical finding (AAF) for 3-OH Stanozolol & 16B - OH Stanozolol (Stanozolol Metabolites), Anabolic Steroid.

2. Adverse analytical finding for Ephedrine at the concentration of 20 µg/ml(SD ±0.2) which exceeds the reporting decision limit (DL) of 11 µg/ml in accordance with the reporting rules in WADA TD2017DL (Ver.2.0). The relative combined slandered uncertainty (Uc %) estimated by the Laboratory for a result at the threshold of 10 µg/ml, is 4%, which does not exceed the relative Ucmx (5%) specified in WADA TD2017DL. This result meets the requirement of WADA TD2017DL(Ver.2.0) for an Adverse Analytical Findings for the presence of Ephedrine in this sample at a concentration greater than the threshold of 10 µg/ml.

3. Adverse analytical finding for Oxilofrine (para-hydroxy ephedrine), a metabolite of Ephedrine, in respect of the above Urine Sample Code number 4067569 of the athlete, Mr. Danushka Perera.

Until the Decision of the Sri Lanka Anti - Doping Disciplinary Panel is received in connection with this matter, the above athlete; Mr. Danushka Perera is provisionally suspended in taking part in any sport related activities.

Please make arrangements to inform the above athlete concerned, Mr. Danushka Perera to report to Sri Lanka Anti - Doping Agency (at National Institute of Sports Science Premises) No. 100/7, Independence Avenue, Colombo 07, at 10.30 a.m. on Tuesday 06.02.2018 and inform whether he would proceed for the B sample analysis or not.

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


