Considering our main objective, they have identified the main issue which is the lack of information regarding prohibited substances. Annually World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) declares a list of prohibited substances in sports. That list contains the names of each chemical compound, not the generic name of medicines, making it a more a technical document. The WADA Prohibited List includes some substances which might cause unintentional doping for athletes as doctors are prescribing them for actual diseases.

Purpose:

To assist athletes to check the status of their medication purchased in Sri Lanka as a part of promoting clean and fair sport in the country before this becomes a social menace.

Solution:

Mobile App in this digital world has a pivotal role, we have newly developed an Android mobile App calling DR App (Drug Reference App), containing all the relevant details on prohibited status of all registered medicines in Sri Lanka and there is an official website for this app.

App Features:

- Checks for prohibited status of brands and ingredients. (Indicated using colours as traffic light system and easy to recognise prohibited status at one time look).
- Simple display of prohibited status, distinguishing "out of competition" and "in competition"
- Details on sports specific characteristics.
- Details concerning different routes of administration
- Information upon WADA substance classifications
- PDF download with search details or send as email to own e-mail
- Save Searched items into the Quick search list
- Guidance activity for first time users and User Manual includes
- Quick Search

- Provides athletes and support personnel with information about the prohibited status of specific medications based on the current WADA Prohibited List.
- Easy tracking
- Save search details for further reference
- Share information on prohibited status with others using any sharing method
- Doctors can see the prohibited status of the medicines before issuing for an athlete
